

The Promoter

1. This competition ("the Competition") is promoted by Aviva Central Services UK Limited ("**Aviva**"), registered in England and Wales under company number 03259447, with its registered office at 8 Surrey Street, Norwich, NR1 3NG, (who is the Promoter of the Competition). Certain elements of the Competition will be organised with the support of MHP Group Limited ("**MHP**"), registered in England and Wales under company number 14106014, with its registered office at 60 Great Portland St, London, W1W 7RT.

Eligibility

2. The Competition is open to children who are (i) enrolled at a primary school in the United Kingdom and (ii) aged between 4 and 11 years old, at the date of entry ("**Entrants**"). Entries must be submitted by a parent or legal guardian ("**Parent/Guardian**") on the Entrants' behalf. Employees of Aviva, MHP, and The Wildlife Trusts, and their immediate families, and anyone professionally connected with the Competition, are not eligible to enter.
3. No purchase is necessary to enter the Competition.

Competition Period

4. The Competition opens at 00:01 (GMT/BST) on 17th September 2026 and closes at 23:59 (GMT/BST) on 3rd November 2026 (the "**Closing Date**"). This period is the "**Competition Period**". Entries received after the Closing Date will not be considered as part of the Competition. The Promoter reserves the right to extend or shorten the Competition Period at its sole discretion.

How to Enter

5. Entries must be submitted via the dedicated email address at RainforestExplorers@MHPSGroup.com. To enter, the Entrant's Parent/Guardian must also provide: (a) the Entrant's first name and age category; (b) the Entrant's school name; (c) the Parent/Guardian's contact details (name, email address, and telephone number); (d) a single photograph taken by the Entrant; (e) a short caption (no more than 50 words) describing the photograph; (f) confirmation that the entered image has not been created or enhanced through AI; (g) confirmation as to whether the photograph is being submitted in the Rainforest Explorers or Concrete Jungle category; and (h) confirmation of acceptance of these Terms and Conditions and the required consent declarations.
6. Each Entrant may submit one entry only, although Parents/Guardians may themselves submit entries on behalf of more than one Entrant. Multiple entries

from the same Entrant will result in all entries from that Entrant being disqualified.

The Photograph

7. The photograph submitted by each Entrant must have been taken by the Entrant during the Competition Period. It must depict a UK temperate rainforest (see further details about these here: [temperate rainforest](#)) or a local green space (for example, a park, woodland, forest, or nature reserve) and must be inspired by the Competition theme as published on the Competition Page. The photograph must not include any identifiable individuals (including the Entrant) unless separate, explicit written consent has been obtained from all identifiable persons (or, in the case of children, their Parent/Guardian).
8. To constitute eligible entries, submitted photographs must:
 - a. not contain content that is offensive, defamatory, obscene, illegal, or which infringes the intellectual property or other rights of any third party; and
 - b. be submitted in JPEG or PNG format and must be a minimum of 5-15 MBs in resolution. Minor adjustments to brightness, contrast, and cropping are permitted, but photographs must not be materially digitally altered or manipulated.

The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any entry that, in its sole opinion, does not comply with these requirements.

Intellectual Property

9. By submitting an entry, the Parent/Guardian warrants that the photograph is the original work of the Entrant, that no third-party intellectual property rights are infringed by the entry, and that the Parent/Guardian has full authority to grant the rights set out in these Terms and Conditions.
10. The copyright in each photograph shall remain with the Entrant (and/or their Parent/Guardian). By entering, the Parent/Guardian grants to Aviva and MHP a non-exclusive, royalty-free, sub-licensable, worldwide licence to use, reproduce, publish, and display the photograph in connection with the Competition, any associated publicity, Aviva's corporate communications, the Aviva website and Get Ready Hub, and any online gallery of winning or highly commended entries, for a period of two years from the Closing Date. The Parent/Guardian may withdraw this licence at any time by contacting

RainforestExplorers@MHPGroup.com provided that each of Aviva and MHP shall have a reasonable period to remove the photograph from its channels.

Judging

11. A panel of judges comprising young wildlife photographer Jamie Smart, an Aviva representative, and a representative of The Wildlife Trusts (the "**Judging Panel**") will assess all valid entries and select the winning and highly commended entries. Entries will be judged on: (a) creativity and originality; (b) connection to the Competition theme; (c) composition and visual impact; and (d) the accompanying caption.
12. Judging will take place within 21 days of the Closing Date. The Judging Panel's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the outcome.

Prizes

13. For the 'Rainforest Explorer' competition category there will be two overall winners selected: one from the age group 4-7 and one from the age group 8-11. For the 'Urban Explorer' competition category there will be two overall winners selected: one from the age group 4-7 and one from the age group 8-11. These winners are the "First Prize Winners".
14. For each of the 'Rainforest Explorer' competition category and the 'Urban Explorer' competition category there will be one Highly Commended Entrant selected. No distinction will be made between age groups in the Rainforest Explorers competition category for the selection of the Highly Commended Entrant.
15. The two First Prize Winners from the 'Rainforest Explorer' competition category will each receive a wildlife photography masterclass featuring young wildlife photographer Jamie Smart as a guest photographer (the "**Masterclass Prize**"). The Masterclass will be facilitated and supervised by adult event staff appointed by MHP.
16. The two winners from the 'Urban Explorer' competition category and two Highly Commended Entrants will each receive a copy of a book written by Hamza Yassin that has been signed by Hamza Yassin.
17. Prizes are non-transferable, non-exchangeable, and no cash alternative is available.

18. The Promoter reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if the stated prize becomes unavailable for reasons beyond the Promoter's control.

Safeguarding - Masterclass Prize

19. The Promoter is committed to safeguarding the welfare of all children involved in this Competition. The following measures will apply to the Masterclass Prize:
20. The Masterclass will take place at Coedydd Maentwrog National Nature Reserve.
21. The First Prize Winners must each be accompanied by their Parent/Guardian (or another named adult with parental responsibility) (the "Supervisor") at all times during the Masterclass. The Supervisor remains responsible for supervising their child throughout the event. The Supervisor is responsible for the safe arrival and departure of participating children from the Rainforest Masterclass, including any supervision required when travelling to and from the venue and when crossing roads or navigating public areas.
22. A designated safeguarding lead appointed by Aviva or MHP will be present throughout the session. No child will be left in a one-to-one or unsupervised situation with any adult at any point during the event. Appropriate enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks will be obtained for all adults who will be leading activities or interacting directly with children, including the designated safeguarding lead, event facilitators, and members of any filming crew where relevant. All event staff and suppliers will receive a safeguarding briefing in advance of the Masterclass.
23. As Jamie Smart is under 18, she will participate as a featured guest photographer and will attend with her own parent/guardian or chaperone. Overall responsibility for the event and supervision of attending children will sit with the adult event staff (including a designated facilitator or producer appointed by MHP). Jamie Smart will not be placed in a position of responsibility for other children.
24. The Promoter will conduct a full written risk assessment of the venue and activity before the Masterclass takes place, covering both safeguarding and outdoor safety considerations. A copy of the risk assessment will be shared with the winning Entrant's Parent/Guardian in advance upon request.
25. The Promoter will provide the Parent/Guardian with full details of the Masterclass arrangements (including venue, attendees, duration, and safeguarding protocols) at least 30 days before the event. The Parent/Guardian will be required to sign a consent form confirming their agreement to the

arrangements, their attendance, and consent for any photography or filming during the Masterclass of the First Prize Winner for whom they are responsible (for example, for use on the Aviva website, Get Ready Hub, or in campaign materials). The Parent/Guardian may withdraw consent for photography or filming at any time.

26. If a Supervisor is unable to accompany the First Prize Winner for whom they are responsible to the Masterclass on any available date, the Parent/Guardian must notify the Promoter within 14 days of being notified of the Masterclass details and the Promoter reserves the right to award the Masterclass Prize to the next highest-ranked Entrant.

Notification of Winners

27. Winners will be notified by email using the contact details provided on the entry form within 30 days of the Closing Date and are required to respond as indicated in the email notification in order to claim their prize. If a winner cannot be contacted, or does not respond to the notification within 14 days of the notification, the Promoter reserves the right to disqualify that entry and select an alternative winner.

Publicity

28. By entering the Competition, the Parent/Guardian agrees that winning, runner-up and highly commended entries may be featured in an online gallery on the Aviva website and in associated media coverage, and that the Entrant's first name, age category, and school name may be published in connection with the results, subject to the Parent/Guardian's prior written consent. The Parent/Guardian may decline publicity without affecting entitlement to any prize.

Data Protection

29. Personal data collected in connection with the Competition will be processed by Aviva as data controller in accordance with Aviva's Privacy Policy www.aviva.com/rainforest-explorers. Personal data will be collected for the purposes of administering the Competition, contacting winners, fulfilling prizes, and (where consent is given) publishing results and photographs.
30. Given that the Competition involves the processing of children's personal data, the Promoter will have regard to the ICO's Age Appropriate Design Code (Children's Code) in its handling of all such data. Only the minimum data necessary to administer the Competition will be collected. Children's personal data will not be used for marketing purposes.

31. Parent/Guardian contact details will be retained for a period of six months following the conclusion of the Competition and will then be securely deleted, unless the Parent/Guardian has given separate consent for further communications. Photographs of winning and highly commended entries will be retained for the licence period set out above.
32. Parents/Guardians may exercise their data protection rights (including rights of access, rectification, erasure, and withdrawal of consent) by contacting RainforestExplorers@MHPGroup.com .
33. Aviva will sometimes need to make decisions jointly with MHP about how personal data will be used in connection with the Competition. In particular, Aviva and MHP will work together to fulfil the safeguarding requirements connected with the Competition and Masterclass Prize. In legal terms, Aviva and MHP are 'joint controllers' in respect of these safeguarding activities. MHP will process personal data in connection with the safeguarding activities in accordance with MHP's privacy policy www.aviva.com/rainforest-explorers. In relation to the joint safeguarding activities, Parents/Guardians may also exercise their data protection rights (including rights of access, rectification, erasure, and withdrawal of consent) by contacting RainforestExplorers@MHPGroup.com at MHP.

Limitation of Liability

34. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Promoter accepts no liability for: (a) entries that are lost, delayed, corrupted, or not received for any reason, including technical failures; (b) any injury, loss, or damage arising from participation in the Competition or acceptance of a prize, except where caused by the negligence of the Promoter; or (c) the acts or omissions of any third party in connection with the Competition.
35. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions excludes or limits liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence, fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation, or any other liability that cannot be excluded or limited by law.

General

36. The Promoter reserves the right to cancel, amend, or suspend the Competition or these Terms and Conditions at any time if, in its reasonable opinion,

circumstances arise that require it to do so. Any such changes will be published on the Competition Page.

37. These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of England and Wales, and any disputes relating to the Competition or these Terms and Conditions shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.

38. By submitting an entry, the Parent/Guardian confirms that they have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
